7th Meeting of the Working Group on Women's Economic Empowerment (WGWEE), Tehran, Iran

- 3. Panel discussion on the role of women in the **fight against corruption**.

The main take aways from the 7th Meeting of the WGWEE is the **Tehran Communique on the role of women in the fight against corruption** which will be circulated among Member States soon. Further, the in-person meeting gave the opportunity to Member States to discuss of future collaborations in view of advancing of the field of Women Economic Empowerment in the **Indian Ocean Rim region**.

In addition, during the meeting, delegates had the opportunity to discover some of the **cultural heritage of Tehran** namely the Sadaabad Palace, the Green Palace, as well as the Al-Zhara all-girl University, the oldest all-girl university of the country.
