The Secretary General of the Indian Ocean Rim Association (IORA), Dr. Salman Al Farisi and the Secretary General of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN), Dr. Kao Kim Hourn, signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on 4th September 2023 in Jakarta, Indonesia.

The Signing Ceremony, witnessed by H.E Retno L.P Marsudi, the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Indonesia and the Chair of ASEAN, and H.E. Dr. AK. Momen, MP, the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Bangladesh and the Chair of IORA, exemplifies the commitment of these Associations to fostering deeper ties and strengthening regional partnerships. The MoU outlines cooperation between ASEAN and IORA which will be carried out by their respective Secretariat.

The cooperation spans various key areas:

July - September 2023 - 3rd issue

- 1. Priority Areas of Cooperation
- 2. Blue Economy;
- 3. People-to-People Exchanges
- 4. Digital and Green Economies.

The Indo-Pacific region is expected to reap several advantages from this joint initiative between ASEAN and IORA.

The MoU provides the opportunity for the cooperation between ASEAN and IORA to maintain and enhance peace and prosperity in both regions through the conclusion of mutually beneficial cooperation.




WORKING-LEVEL MEETING WITH DIALOGUE PARTNERS



FOURTH MEETING OF IORA FUNCTIONAL BODIES' CHAIRS AND COORDINATING COUNTRIES (FBC-CC)





At the meeting the Chairs of 10 Functional Bodies of IORA and Coordinating Country for Institutional Arrangements and Broadening Engagement (IABE) presented report on their respective activities covered since the third Meeting of FBC-CC that held on 23 May 2023. They also discussed the challenges they are facing in implementing the work plans of the Functional Bodies and the way forward.

MEETING ON REVIEW MECHANISM OF IORA SPECIALIZED AGENCIES



IORA is an intergovernmental organization which regroups Member States in the region of the Indian Ocean, as well as Dialogue Partners from across the world. It has two specialized agencies namely the Regional Centre for Science and Technology Transfer (RCSTT) based in Iran and the Fisheries Support Unit (FSU) based in Oman. These agencies bring their expertise to IORA, and to make them more impactful it was proposed to review their works on a regular basis to keep aligned to IORA member states' needs. In this regard, the Islamic Republic of Iran hosted a virtual meeting on 19 September 2023 as the lead country to discuss the draft Concept Note on the Review Mechanism of IORA Specialized Agencies.


WORKSHOP ON COOPERATION ON MARITIME SAFETY, 24-28 JULY 2023
